1. Article published in the last year (November issue of the preceding year up to the May issue of the current year).
2. Article is ranked by up to 5 JPDS editors according to the scoring system below.
3. Top 3 scoring articles will be invited to present.
4. Top 3 scoring articles will comprise of 2 original articles and 1 case report, however this is subject to change upon the discretion of the editorial team.
5. The presenter must be the primary author or co-author of the paper. In the event no authors are available to present, the Editor's Pick award will be given to the next ranked article.
6. Presenters will be provided a certificate of presentation and a cash prize.

<b>Results and discussion</b> <i>All relevant data are clearly presented and discussed in the context of existing literature/evidence</i>	30
<b>Writing style</b> <i>Clear, concise, and cohesive manuscript</i>	20

Criteria	Score
<b>Relevance/significance</b> <i>Potential impact of the report to clinical practice/scientific knowledge</i>	20
<b>Complete and concise documentation</b> <i>All pertinent information are included</i>	30
<b>Discussion</b> <i>The case is discussed in the context of existing literature/evidence</i>	30
<b>Writing style</b> <i>Clear, concise, and cohesive manuscript</i>	20
